Whatever the reason, we are here to provide food assistance.



Most Needed Food & Household Items:

- Canned meats
- Meat alternatives (peanut butter, soy, assorted nuts)
- Dairy (canned and powdered milk)
- Canned goods (beans, soup, and stews)
- Canned vegetables and fruit
- Whole grain cereals
- Pasta (canned or dry) and pasta sauces
- Infant foods and baby formula
- Bathroom tissue and diapers
- Personal hygiene products
